This brightly colored pumpkin is the first hybrid Cinderella-type pumpkin on the market which results in a higher yield as well as Powdery Mildew resistance in the garden. Robust and vigorous vines grown in traditional hills produce large fruits ranging from 18-20 pounds, creating a whole grouping of carriages for all the princesses in your family!

Genus species: *Cucurbita maxima*

Common name: Pumpkin

Unique qualities: Pinkish-red colored fruit shaped like the pumpkin carriage from the fairytale Cinderella. Some lucky gardeners could also experience a pale blue pumpkin. Large trailing vine sets up to 5-7 fruit per plant. Well suited for fall decorations and baking. Flesh is yellow, sweet and has a nutty flavor. Requires a large garden space for best results.

Fruit size: 15-18 inches, 18-20 pounds

Fruit shape: Flattened round

Fruit color: Pink red

Plant type: Annual

Plant height: 20 inches

Garden location: Full sun

Garden spacing: Sow 3 seeds directly in garden soil/hill with a 2-3 foot spacing

Length of time to harvest: 100 days
