



Penstemon, 'Arabesque™ Red' F₁

Another AAS Winner for the pollinator garden that the hummingbirds will love! Plus, the first ever penstemon to become an AAS Winner in more than eighty years of trialing. This beauty is a season-long repeat bloomer with large tubular blooms almost one inch across on strong vigorous stems. 'Arabesque™ Red' is best started indoors then transplanted for a longer bloom time. Great for combination containers and can be used as an annual or as a perennial for gardens in zones 6-9. Growers looking for a unique item for the "after-bedding" season should consider this penstemon.
